



Recollected Vistas: The Ceramic Art of Kishi Eiko is our third solo exhibition of contemporary Japanese sculpture by this vibrant artist. Intricate and meticulous technique, combined with a refined sense of form and balance, set Kishi's oeuvre apart from that of any other ceramist. As over three months are required for the completion of just one of her large-scale forms, these eighteen dramatic sculptures represent nearly two years of focused effort. Echoing the

landscape of her Kyoto neighborhood, Kishi now draws upon the architecture of

the nearby, celebrated ancient temples and shrines.

Kishi has exhibited her work internationally in Japan, the US and Europe, consistently winning acclaim and awards since 1984. Major examples of her work may be found in many private and public collections around the world. A fully illustrated catalogue accompanies the exhibition.
